On 17 February 2020, the Grant Contract for the Project for Provision of Equipment for Organic Farmers for needs of Healthier Niue under Japan's Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security (GGP) was signed by Ambassador of Japan to Niue, Hiroyasu Kobayashi and Ms. Maryanne Talagi, Chairperson of Niue Island Organic Farmers Association (NIOFA) at the Embassy of Japan in New Zealand.
