The Grant Contract for the Project for the Construction of Multi-Purpose Classroom of Apii Te Uki Ou Primary School 2020 under Japan's Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Project (GGP) was signed on 9 March 2021 by Tony Fe'ao, Chairman, Board of Governors for Apii Te Uki Ou in Rarotonga in the Cook Islands and on 16 March 2021 by Ambassador ITO Koichi in the Embassy of Japan in New Zealand respectively.

With this Project the Government of Japan will provide grant assistance of NZ\$ 128,948 for the construction of a Multi-Purpose Classroom (usually to be used as two classrooms) in Apii Te Uki Ou Primary School. The project aims to contribute to improving the learning environment for students and teachers by creating additional learning spaces and meeting the demands of the growing school population.

The Multi-Purpose Classroom will also be used without removable partitions, for school events and community activities. It is also expected to be utilised as a shelter in case of emergencies.
