Since 2015, 173 people from all over the world have been appointed as Goodwill Ambassadors, and this year, three people from New Zealand, for the first time, were appointed.

When handing over the letters of appointment, Ambassador Ito encouraged Mr Hamada to continue his efforts promoting Japanese culture through food. To this, Mr Hamada replied, "The reason we have been able to overcome the Christchurch earthquake and COVID-19 and continue our Japanese restaurants is due to the wide support from our customers and the efforts of those before us who overcame various hardships to promote Japanese cuisine in this country. With this appointment, I will continue to work creatively to make Japanese food culture known to even more Kiwis."
